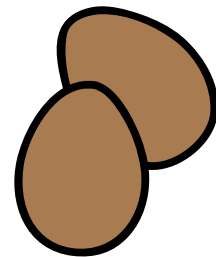
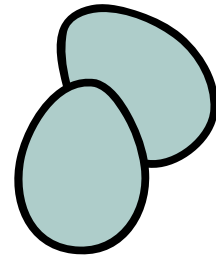
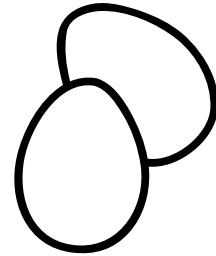
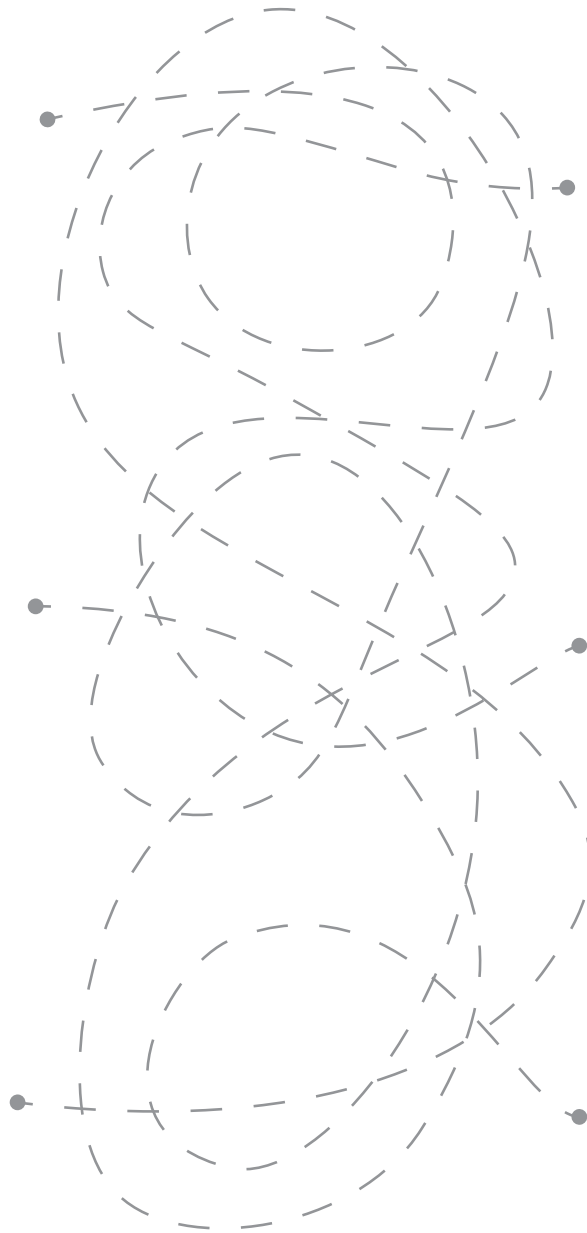
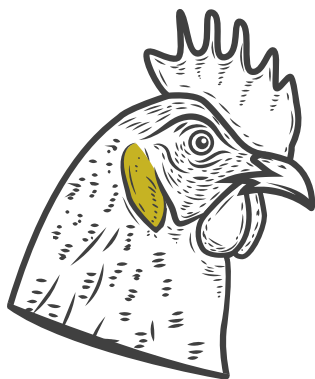
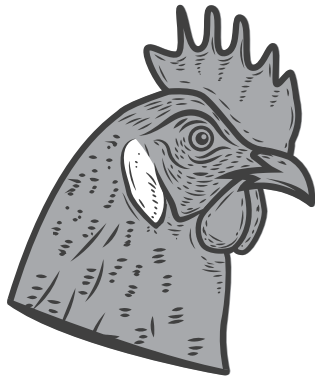
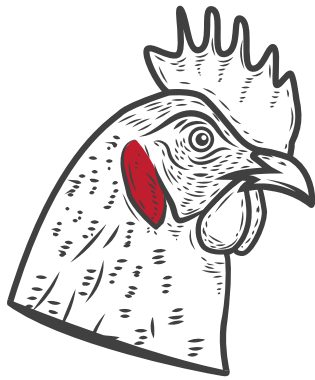
Little Chick went exploring in the yard and got lost.

Did You Know? The wattle is the red skin underneath the beak. Blood circulates between this and the comb to regulate body temperature.

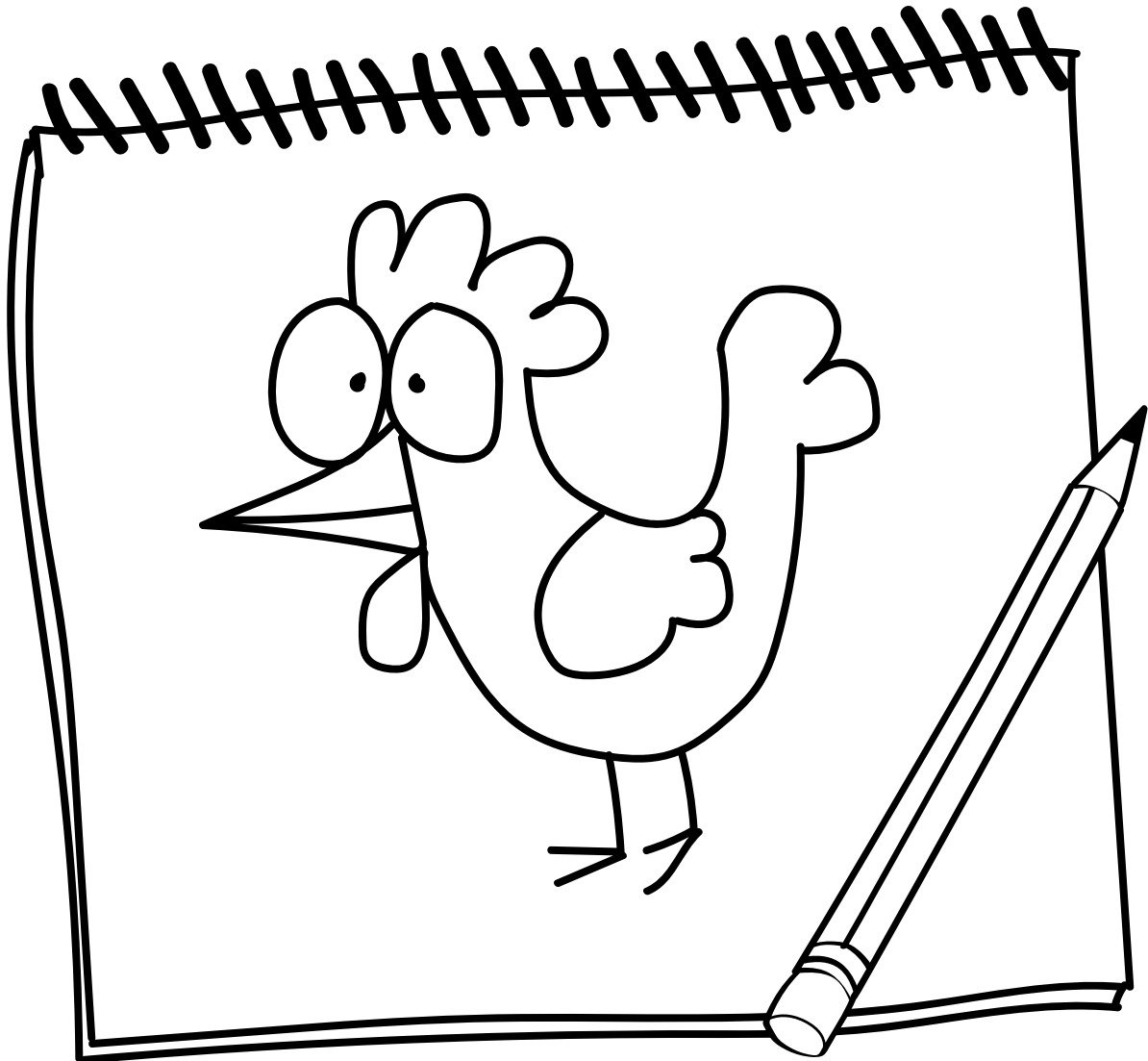
Match the Ears to the Egg

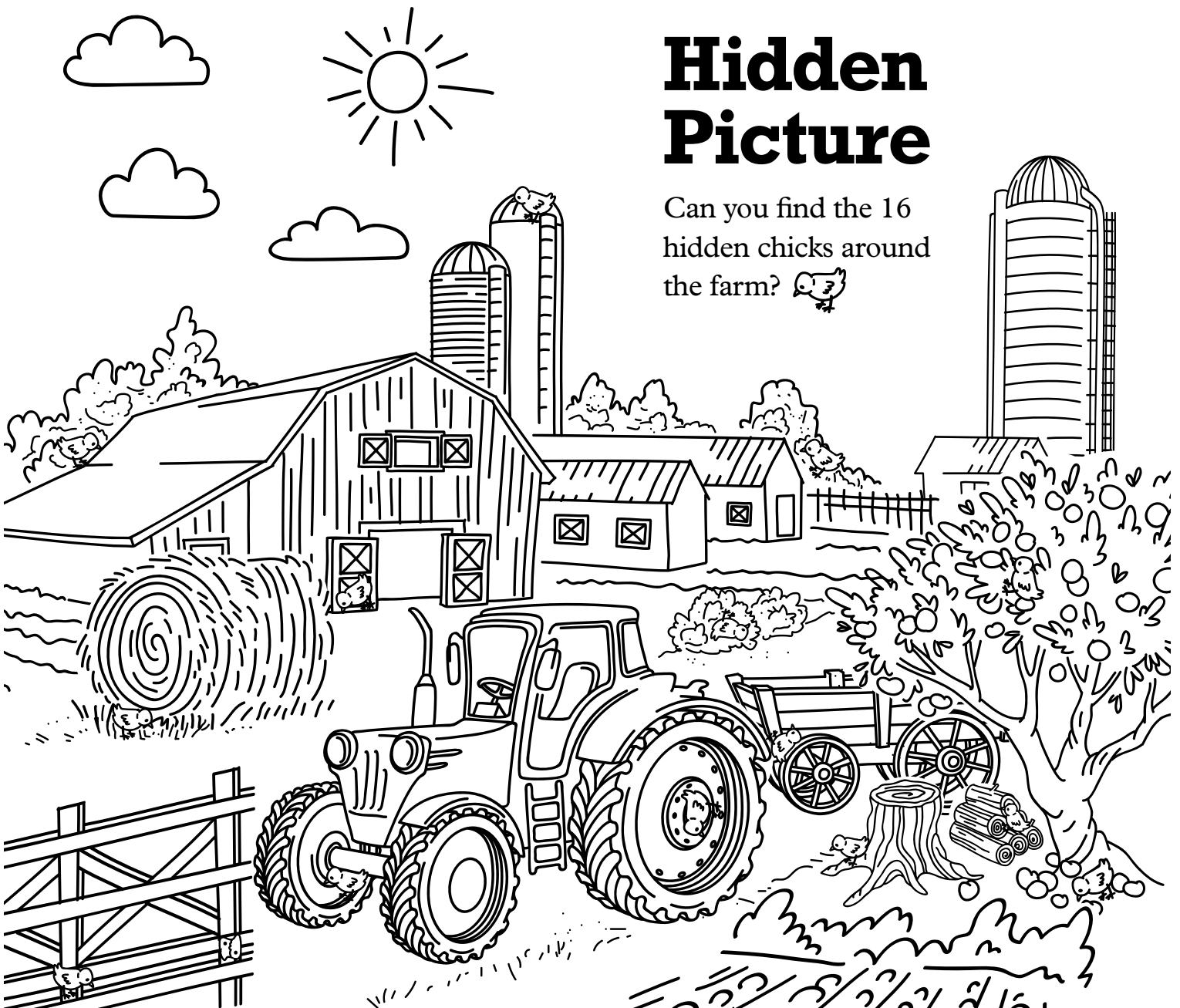

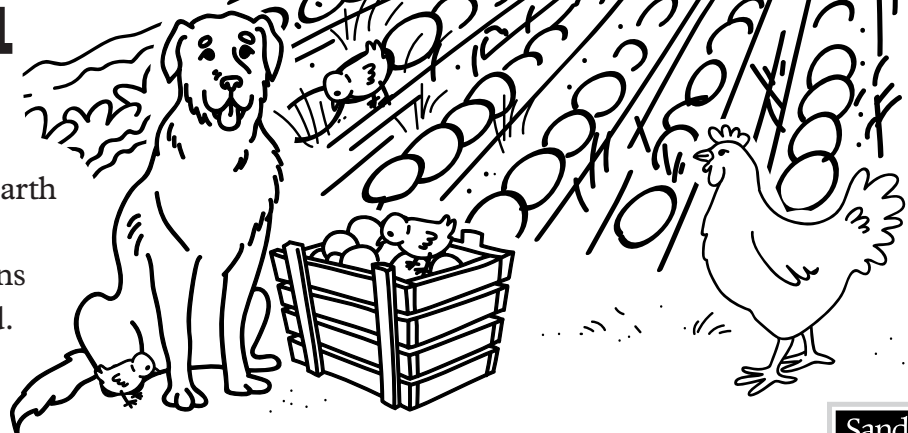

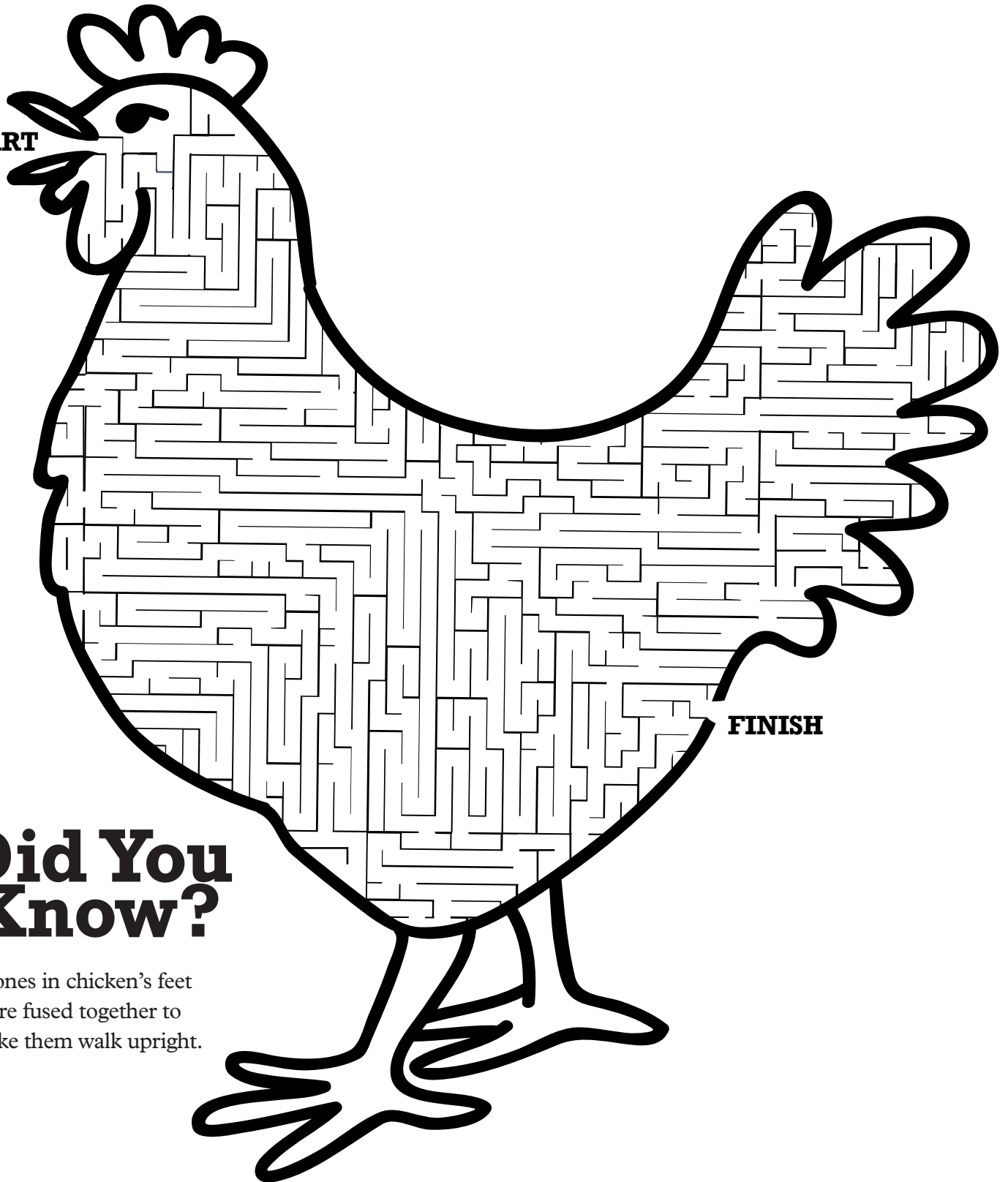
Did You Know?

crayons or markers



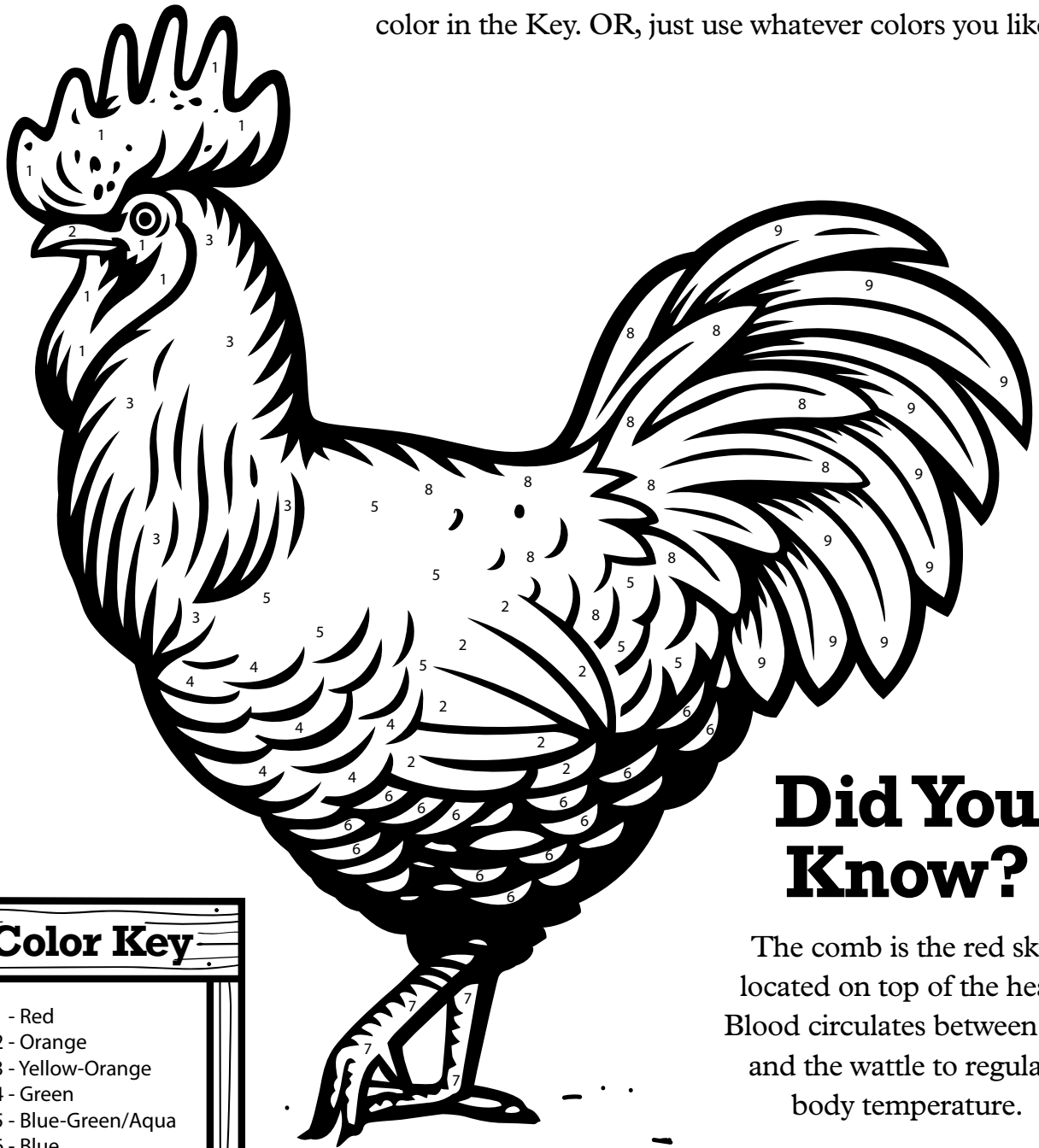

The comb is the red skin located on top of the head. Blood circulates between this and the wattle to regulate body temperature.


Plumage refers to the feathers that cover the bird's body.

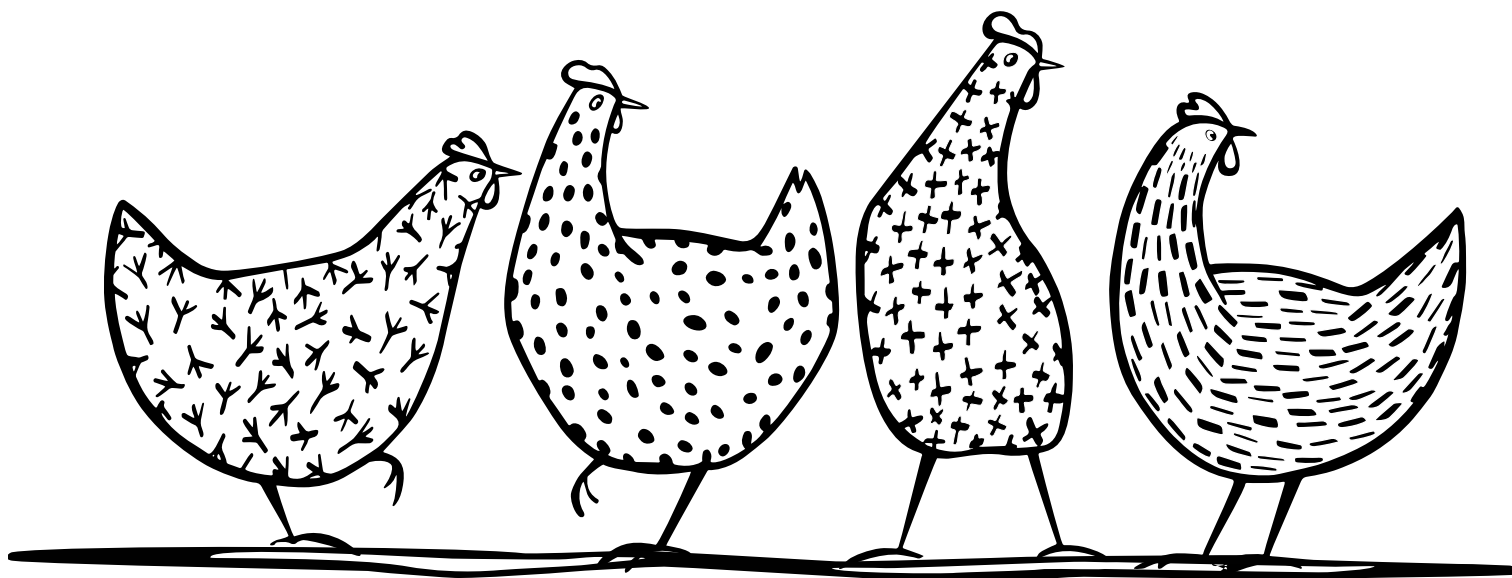
Chickens can remember over 100 different people or animal faces.

is called Alektorophobia.

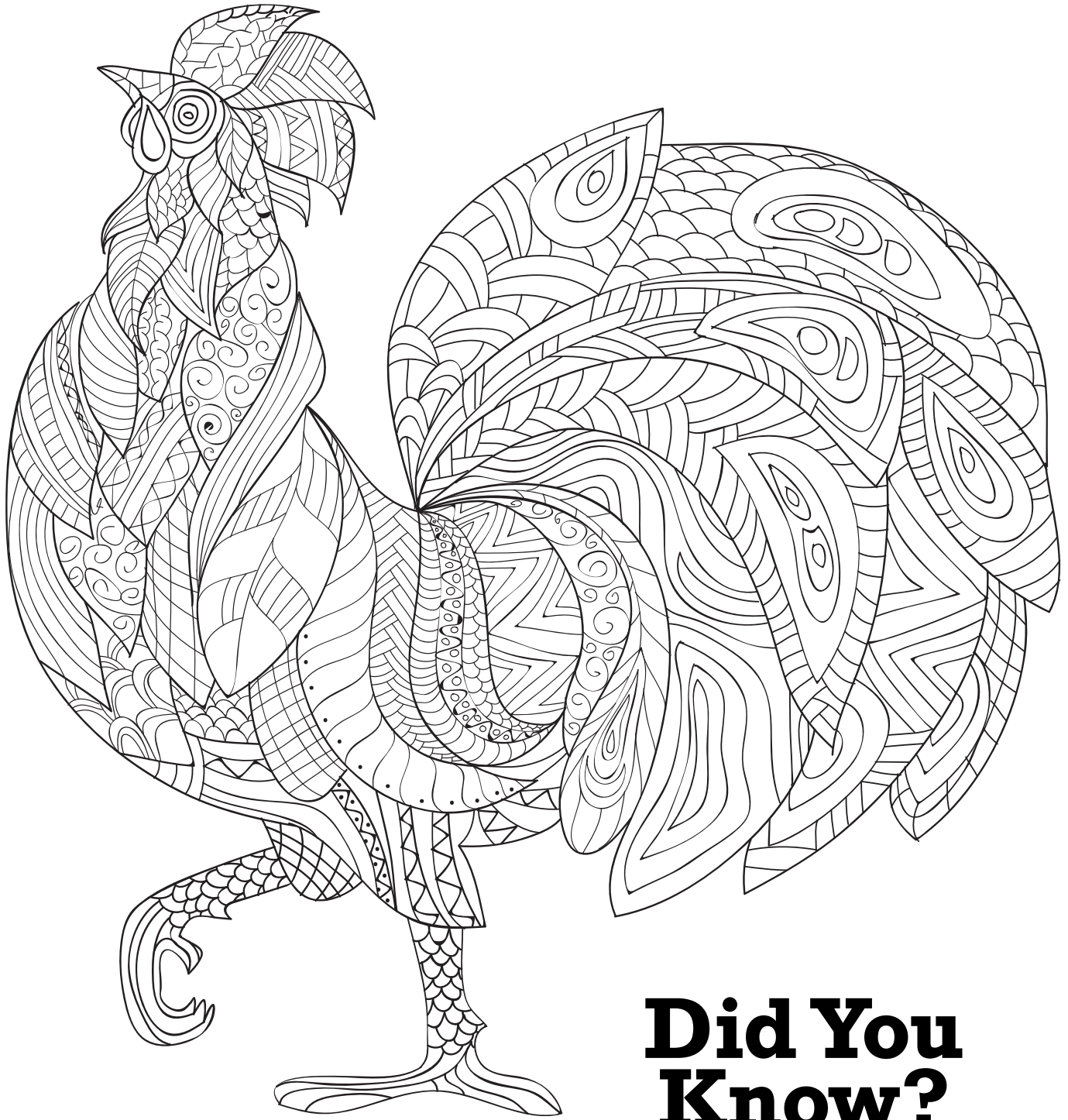




Did You Know?

Broiler chickens are raised for meat.

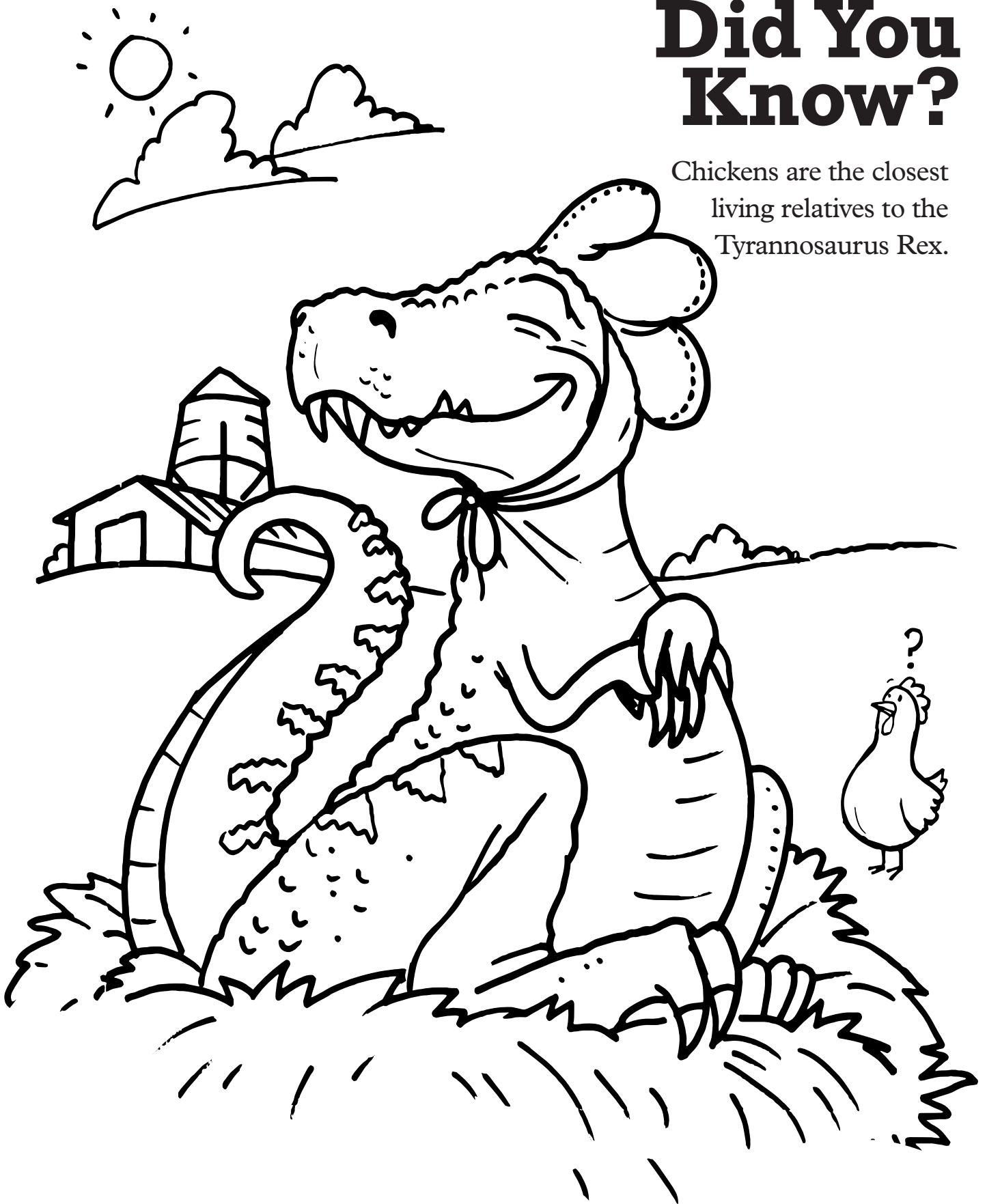


Did You Know?

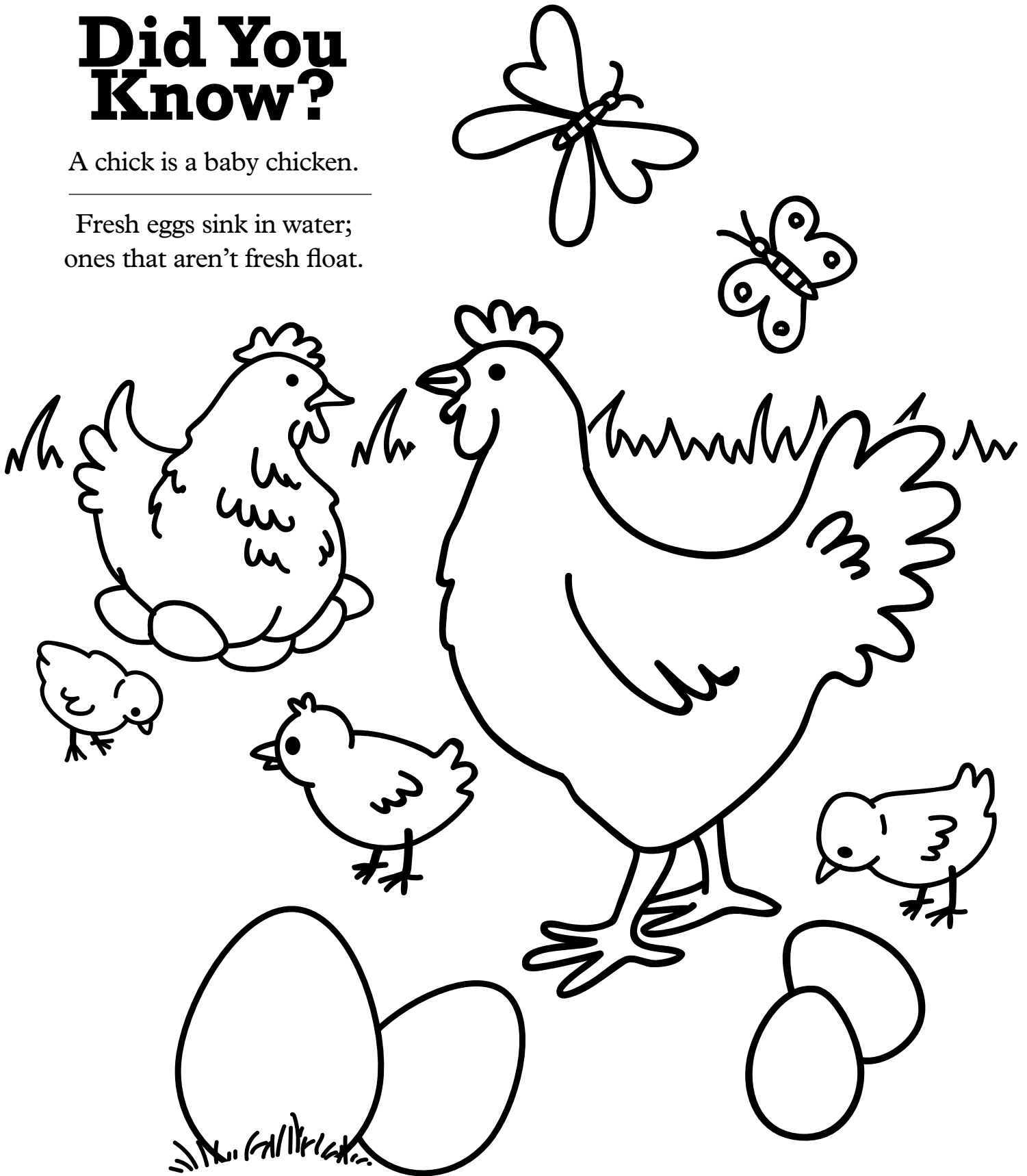
Chickens are the closest living relatives to the Tyrannosaurus Rex.
