



Little Chick went exploring in the yard and got lost. Can you help her find her way back home?






The wattle is the red skin underneath the beak. Blood circulates between this and the comb to regulate body temperature.



# Match the Ears to the Egg


Untangle the lines to find out which hen lays which egg.



**Did you know?** Chickens have ear lobes and the color of the ear lobe determines what color egg the hen will lay.








#### Color Key-



## Did You Know?


The comb is the red skin located on top of the head. Blood circulates between this and the wattle to regulate body temperature.

Plumage refers to the feathers that cover the bird's body.














Layer chickens are raised to lay eggs. Broiler chickens are raised for meat.






Not all roosters have colorful plumage. Some male chickens look quite ordinary!
