THEY SAY...

"IF CHICKENS USE THE SAME ANTIBIOTICS AS PEOPLE, THOSE ANTIBIOTICS WILL BECOME INEFFECTIVE TO HUMANS OVER TIME."

ACTUALLY ...

The types of antibiotics used for chickens are different from the ones commonly used by humans. According to the American Meat Institute, "The vast majority of antibiotics are used either in people, or in animals, but not both ... The claim that most 'medically important' antibiotics are used in animals is not supported by the data."

BUT REALLY ...

Sanderson Farms does not use unnecessary antibiotics in their poultry. Dr. Phil Stayer explains, "We don't think any antibiotics used in Sanderson Farms flocks are unnecessary. We won't order antibiotics to be used unless the veterinarians deem them needed for flock health reasons."

Conventionally raised chickens are not raised in cages but are actually raised in large, open structures known as "grow out houses." These houses are well equipped with systems to steadily provide feed and water to the birds, as well as carefully control lighting and fresh air to avoid any undue stress.
